Smart tools for safer skies: Aircraft Compliance debuts at EAA AirVenture 2026 with maintenance tracking built around the regulations, plus a maintenance command center that turns the compliance calendar itself into a budget-vs-actual picture for the owner-pilot.

THOMPSON FALLS, Mont., July 14, 2026 — Blue sky, full tanks, and a runway pointed straight at the horizon. Adventure is calling and aviation is your passion. The only thing between you and wheels-up is one question: *is my aircraft compliant?* **Aircraft Compliance** answers it before you ask: transponder check current, that AD logged, the next annual counting down in plain sight. See it at a glance, complete your pre-flight, then inch that throttle forward like the runway is tugging at you. The app makes its public debut at **EAA AirVenture 2026** in Oshkosh, Wis. (July 20–26).

Aircraft Compliance organizes your records of general aviation aircraft ownership (logbooks, inspections, Airworthiness Directives, registration, required documents) into a single, plain-language readiness picture. Instead of juggling multiple spreadsheets, bookmarked websites, and paper manuals, the owner sees one thing first: **is this aircraft compliant right now, and what’s coming due**. Color-coded alerts count down every deadline *before* it arrives, and every annual, AD, and squawk posts its real cost, so the owner watches **budget, actual, and variance** add up in real time. Squawks can be queued sequentially, then emailed straight from the app to the A&P, streamlining your whole maintenance workflow while records sync across phone, tablet, and computer.

“This is about staying in command of your aircraft’s readiness,” said Travis Carney, founder of Aircraft Compliance. “One glance confirms you’re current and airworthy before every flight, so a recent squawk or a fresh annual never becomes a surprise far from home.”
